To the Town of Avon,

Pines West HOA is formally requesting to be included in the research of the Town of Avon Safety Program.

Our neighborhood is only 7-8 years old and we have continually had problems with speeders for at least 7 of those years. Our neighborhood is unique in that we have one main entrance, which is Weeping Way Lane. This street goes from the front of the complex straight to the back of the complex with only one stop sign in between. Because of this, the neighborhoods to the east and west of us who have long winding roads with multiple stop signs use our neighborhood to gain entrance to theirs. These neighborhoods are Pines of Avon and Stone Mill. Stone Mill residents being the biggest offenders, on a daily basis fly down Weeping Way, blowing right through the only stop sign we have to gain entrance to their neighborhood. We have called the Avon police and have had an officer to one of our meetings several years ago. We are always told to get the plate number, but when we do we are told there is nothing they can do if they don't witness it. We have had residents follow these drivers to their driveways and complain, but nothing seems to reduce the problem.

If something major does not change we all expect that sooner or later a child is going to be killed on Weeping Way Lane. We have a large number of children in our neighborhood. At least twelve children live on just one of the courts right off of Weeping Way.
